Since the beginning of August, Snowdonia Donkeys have been enjoying the grass and tranquillity at Moelyci. Snowdonia Donkeys works with people to promote health and well-being by organising accompanied walks and contact sessions with these gentle creatures.

We don't offer rides, instead our donkeys have pack saddles to enable them to carry picnics to encourage our visitors to walk in the beautiful Welsh countryside. The donkeys at Moelyci; Walter, Winifred and Jenny, have regularly walked the Heritage Trail with visitors and sometimes ventured further afield. Snowdonia Donkeys have also been working with organisations including Teulu Ni and Action for Children offering bespoke activities for individuals and groups. The facilities at Moelyci has enabled us to hold a Saturday Club which offers theory and practical sessions for young people interested in donkeys. On August Bank holiday we held an open day for our volunteers and supporters. The donkeys met new people as well as old friends and many enjoyed the coffee being served at the café. New developments coming soon...

- **Specialist cheese dairy**
On behalf of sheep's cheese producer Carrie Rimes we are applying for planning permission to build her a new dairy building with underground cheese store. Carrie's yoghurts and ice cream are already available to buy in the new Ffarm shop.
- **Biomass Zone**
Known for its community composting site Moelyci is looking to revitalise this, but focus on extracting valuable nutrients and energy from currently surplus or unused biomass. Grasses, bracken, soft rush are all valuable resources that can yield a return given the right approach. Plans for converting the old composting site are being drawn up and will be coming forward this autumn. If you have ambitions in the biomass enterprise then get in touch.
- **Renewable energy**
This will be needed at Ffarm Moelyci, to heat and power the newly energised enterprise activities. We are at the early stages of looking at what forms of renewable energy – biomass, ground source heat, solar PV etc. – will be suited to the farm. As importantly we are planning to explore how energy is stored and distributed around the farm as an example of how other farms and villages might become self-sufficient.
